## **TERMS 2-4**

3 credits of English General Education Requirement Composition and Introduction to Literature 2 (if students have not taken ENG 121), 3 credits of Health/Fitness/ Wellness General Education Requirement, 6 credits of Social & Behavioral Science GER (two different disciplines), 6-7 credits of Biological & Physical Sciences GER (including one lab), 3 credits of Arts & Humanities GER (other than COM), 12 credits from a single discipline, and electives. (Students must take the amount of elective credits to achieve a minimum of 60 credits that are required for this degree.)
