## TERMS 2-4

Below are the 44 credit hours of course requirements that should be met during Terms 2-4. Students must meet with an Academic Advisor before choosing any of these classes:

3 credits of English General Education Requirement Composition and Introduction to Literature 2 (if students have not taken ENG 121), 3 credits of Health/Fitness/Wellness General Education Requirement, 3 credits of Social & Behavioral Science GER (other than SOC or PSY), 6-7 credits of Biological & Physical Sciences GER (including one lab), 6 credits of Arts & Humanities GER (two different disciplines), 12 credits from a single discipline, and electives. (Students must take the amount of elective credits to achieve a minimum of 60 credits that are required for this degree.)
